Of the prints that could be processed, fingerprint results identified approximately 1, 800 temporary workers (1.1 percent of total hires) with criminal records that name check alone failed to identify. Of the 1, 800 workers with criminal records, approximately 750 (42 percent) were terminated or were further reviewed because the Bureau determined their criminal records - which included crimes such as rape, manslaughter, and child abuse - disqualified them from census employment. Projecting these percentages to the 35, 700 temporary employees with unclassifiable prints, it is possible that...
