The focus of Mind Stretchers is on activities that build creative thinking skills and widen students perspectives beyond the correct response. For example, one activity, Which Would You Take, asks your students to leave a message in the wilderness telling other members of their camping party that they are fishing. The trick is that they don't have a pen or pencil, but they do have a coffee pot, matches, a canteen, a flashlight, and a hatchet.
