It contains the list of Sheriffs to the year 1641, the Gentry of 1433, with some miscellaneous notices of the celebrated characters who have been natives of each county. In 1719, Ashinole s notes of arms and monumental inscriptions, which he had taken in a personal survey of all the churches in Berkshire, during the years 1665 and 1666, were published in three volumes 8vo.
